HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on Thursday, August 28, 2008 at approximately 11:18 P.M. The homicide occurred at 1620 Northwest 25 Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that the victim, Arthur D. Robinson, was outside his front door on his patio. A few moments later, his wife heard what sounded like a gun shot. Upon appearing at the front of the home, Robinson's wife found him lying on the ground suffering from a gunshot wound. Robinson was transported to Broward General Medical Center where he was pronounced deceased.

The suspect was described as a black male between the ages of eighteen to nineteen years old. He was last seen running from this location in an unknown direction. The suspect also has braids that are shoulder length. Police are looking into several motives in this case, including a disturbance that may have occurred in this neighborhood several weeks earlier.
