**RESIDENTIAL  
BURGLARIES**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is currently investigating three residential burglaries that occurred within one week. The first burglary occurred at approximately 3:14 P.M. at a residence located at 3031 Northeast 51<sup>st</sup> Street. The second burglary occurred at approximately 2:45 P.M. at a residence located at 2900 Northeast 44<sup>th</sup> Street. The third burglary occurred at approximately 3:35 P.M. at a residence located at 2501 Northeast 40<sup>th</sup> Street, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that during each burglary the unknown suspects gained entry into the residence by distracting the home owner and then removed the victim's valuables.

During the investigation detectives have discovered several similarities in the details surrounding each incident, which has led detectives to believe the same suspects are responsible for these residential burglaries.
