FLPD RELEASES 2017 CRIME STATISTICS

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is proud to release our 2017 Part One Crime statistics for the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Throughout 2017, the Fort Lauderdale Police Department increased our committment to our crime reduction strategy through the application of traditional intelligence gathering and enforcement combined with the implementation of new investigative techniques and technology. We also remained focused on building new relationships and stregnthening our existing relationships with our neighbors throughout the city.

Part One Crimes are subcategorized into violent crimes and property crimes. Violent crimes include homicide, forcible sex offenses, robbery, and aggravated assualt, and decreased by a total of 7%. Notably, there was a 10% reduction in robberies.

Property crimes include burglary, larceny, and vehicle theft, and decreased by a total of 6%. This included a 14% decrease in residential burglaries. There was a 6% decrease in overall Part One Crime based on the Records Management System (RMS)*.
