TENTED HOME BURGLARIZED

(Suspects in Custody)

ORIGINAL REPORT:

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department has arrested 20 year-old Kendrick Caty and charged him with Residential Burglary and Resisting Arrest.

Last night at approximately 10:00pm, an eyewitness contacted police stating several men had entered a tented residence located at 1625 NW 17th Lane. Patrol officers immediately responded to the area and initiated measures in an attempt to contain the burglars from fleeing the area.

K-9 handlers quickly located Caty and placed him in custody.

Caty was found to be in possession of the victim's property, burglary tools and a pair of socks which were worn over his hands to prevent leaving fingerprints.

UPDATE:

22 year-old Jimmy Burke was also arrested in connection with the above referenced burglary. He was also charged with Residential Burglary and Resisting Arrest.
