TRAFFIC ADVISORY: 2018 FORT LAUDERDALE A1A MARATHON

The 2018 Fort Lauderdale A1A Marathon returns to the City of Fort Lauderdale on Sunday, February 18th. Motorists are encouraged to carefully review the listed road closures and should expect traffic delays from 6:00 A.M. until approximately 12:00 P.M.

The actual race is tentatively scheduled to begin at 6:00 A.M. The Fort Lauderdale Police Department will have officers stationed along the marathon route to guide pedestrians and motorists to ensure public safety. <u>www.a1amarathon.com</u>

Street Closures and Detours for Saturday, February 17th

11:00 P.M. to Sunday, February 18th at approximately 8:00 A.M.:

- Both eastbound and westbound lanes of Southwest 2nd Street, between Southwest 7th Avenue and Southwest 4th Avenue, will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- The Broward Center for the Performing Arts Center parking garage, entrance on SW 5th Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic for event setup, race start and tear down.

Street Closures and Detours for Sunday, February 18th

- 6:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.:
 - Andrews Avenue will be closed from Broward Boulevard to Southeast 5th Street
 - East Las Olas Boulevard will be closed from Andrews Avenue to Southeast 15th Avenue
- 6:30 A.M. to 11:30 A.M.:
 - No vehicular or bicycle traffic will be permitted in the northbound lanes of North State Road A1A from East Las Olas Boulevard North to Sunrise Boulevard.
 - Northbound and southbound traffic along North State Road A1A, between the 800 block of Seabreeze Boulevard and Northeast 36th Street, will be directed to utilize the southbound lanes of North State Road A1A.
 - Eastbound traffic on East Sunrise Boulevard will have access to a detour by uniform police personnel at North State Road A1A to travel either northbound or southbound in the counter flow lanes.
 - Absolutely NO beachside parallel parking will be permitted along North State Road A1A, on the east side of the road, between Northeast 14th Street and Northeast 19th Street

Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes to avoid delays until 12:30 P.M. Event organizers have placed message signboards throughout the race route providing ample time for motorists to prepare for the above closures.
