DRUG ENFORCEMENT VICE UNIT MAKE SEVERAL ARREST

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department initiated "Operation Dead End" in an effort to combat narcotics related crimes in the area of 500 West Sunrise Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The goal of this operation was to improve the quality of life for all residents, business owners and visitors of our city by reducing the narcotics related criminal activity through various policing techniques.

As a result of a six month long undercover operation the Drug Enforcement Vice Unit Detectives along with Fort Lauderdale Patrol Officers, several individuals were successfully identified who were facilitating narcotic sales and distributing narcotics in the area. Detectives established criminal charges against these individuals as well.

On Thursday, May 3rd at approximately 6:00 P.M., detectives seized an unknown amount of narcotics, one firearm and arrested the following subjects;

- Marc Felenon, B/M, 11/23/87, resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

This is an active investigation.
