MAN NABBED FOR CONVENIENCE STORE ROBBERIES

Today, the Fort Lauderdale Police Department, Violent Crimes Unit, have charged Clarence Jacobs, 12/4/1985, a Hollywood resident, with three counts of Armed Robbery.

On March 10, 2008 at 8:30am, Jacobs entered Star-K Food Store, located at 2509 SW 9th Avenue, and robbed the clerk, Gennard Dellatore, at knifepoint. He fled the store with \$400.00 in cash and was not located.

On March 16, 2008 at 8:40am, Jacobs returned to the same convenience store and attempted to rob Dellatore a second time. This time the clerk was prepared and pointed a "stun-gun" at Jacobs. Jacobs brandished a knife but did leave the store empty handed.

Minutes later at 8:50am, Jacobs entered the Stop-n-Save located at 1505 SW 20th Street and robbed the clerk at knifepoint. He fled the store with \$150.00 in cash and was not immediately captured.

Detectives gathered information on the case and identified Jacobs through an anonymous caller. Jacobs was located in the Broward County Main Jail where he was arrested previously on drug charges.
