**TRAFFIC SAFETY  
CHECKPOINT:  
RESCHEDULED**

**UPDATE 12.4.18:** The Fort Lauderdale Police Department's traffic safety checkpoint originally scheduled for November 29<sup>th</sup> has been rescheduled and moved to a new location. The checkpoint will now be conducted on Thursday, December 20<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 P.M. to 4:00 A.M. Friday, December 21<sup>st</sup>. The traffic safety checkpoint will be held for vehicles traveling eastbound in the 1300 block of West Broward Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The safety of our neighbors and visitors is always our top priority. We hope this traffic safety checkpoint serves as a reminder for everyone to be safe while on the roadways this Holiday season.

**ORIGINAL 11.27.18:** The Fort Lauderdale Police Department will be conducting a traffic safety checkpoint on Thursday, November 29<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 A.M. to 5:00 A.M., in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The traffic safety checkpoint will be held for traffic traveling eastbound in the 500 block of West Broward Boulevard.

The checkpoint will consist of a single lane closure for eastbound traffic on West Broward Boulevard.

Vehicles will be systematically selected and officers will be conducting safety checks along with checking drivers' licenses, vehicle registrations and proof of insurance.

The traffic safety checkpoint is being set up in response to numerous complaints regarding speeding and miscellaneous traffic violations in the area.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department does not expect any increased traffic delays due to the traffic checkpoint.
