BUSINESS BURGLARY

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a burglary of a business that occurred on January 18, 2008 between the hours of 5:00 P.M. and 11:50 P.M. The burglary occurred at 3000 Northeast 30th Place, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that three black males entered the business location, which has multiple offices and burglarized nine businesses in total. The first black male was last seen wearing a gray shirt with black pants. The second male had on a black shirt with black pants. The final male was wearing a white shirt with blue jeans and he appears to have earrings in both of his ears.

The loss of this burglary includes a digital camera, video camera. Three Black Berry Cellular phones, MP3 player, CD player, and an Apple lap top computer. Also taken were a Dell lap top computer, a safe, and jewelry.
