TORTUGA MUSIC FESTIVAL
ADVISORY

The Tortuga Music Festival will be held at the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park, 1100 Seabreeze Boulevard Friday, April 12th through Sunday, April 14th. The event is scheduled on Friday, April 12th from 12:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. The event is scheduled from 12:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. on both Saturday, April 13th and Sunday, April 14th.

Organizers anticipate a daily crowd attendance upwards of 30,000 for the event. The event features top country and rock artists, marine conservation exhibits and culinary delights. A portion of the beach is designated for the music festival and will be reserved for ticket holders.

Traffic Advisory:

Motorists are advised that a high volume of traffic and delays may be expected on all barrier island roadways, especially A1A and Seabreeze Boulevard. Delays may also be expected on Southeast 17th Street and Las Olas Boulevard.

East Las Olas Boulevard between Seabreeze Boulevard and A1A is closed due to construction. All eastbound traffic on East Las Olas Boulevard will be directed southbound on Seabreeze. Expect additional congestion and delays in this area.

Taxis, Ubers, Lyfts and ride share users are to utilize the Fort Lauderdale Aquatic Complex parking lot at 501 Seabreeze Blvd. Ride shares are not permitted to pick-up or drop-off at any other location.

There will be no designated event parking. Attendees are encouraged to use the Water Taxi shuttle, running from 10:00 A.M. until Midnight each day. The three locations are as follows:

- GalleryOne DoubleTree Suites (2670 East Sunrise Boulevard) *free parking at Galleria Mall*
- Hilton Fort Lauderdale Marina (1881 Southeast 17th Street)
- Riverside Hotel (620 East Las Olas Boulevard)
