JUVENILE ARRESTED FOR MISUSE OF 911

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department arrested a juvenile on Thursday, April 4th for making the 911 call that was placed on Monday, March 11, 2019 stating that there was a student in possession of a handgun at Dillard High School. The high school is located at 2501 Northwest 11th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that the juvenile placed the 911 call to Broward Sheriff's Office Communications and provided a detailed description of the student carrying a handgun, building location, and claimed that he was hiding in a bathroom for his safety.

As a result of this 911 call Dillard Middle School and Dillard High School were placed on lock down, which resulted in all classes and school functions being suspended for approximately three hours. During that time Fort Lauderdale Police responded to the high school, searching the school room by room. After completing this extensive search no threat was discovered.

Detectives from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department Threat Response Unit have identified the juvenile 911 caller as Kendrick Tymond Green, B/M, 1/18/2005, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Green has been charged with the following:

- One Count Disturbing Peace-Disturb School Function
- One Count Misuse 911 or E911 System Cost Over \$100
