**DETECTIVES SEEK
TO IDENTIFY
TOMMY BAHAMA
BURGLAR**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating two separate business burglaries that occurred in June at the Tommy Bahama store located at 1002 East Las Olas Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The first incident occurred on Saturday, June 22nd at approximately 5:25 A.M. According to surveillance video, an unknown male suspect approached a rear door at the business. The suspect is seen making entry into the business through the unsecured door and moments later, exits with his arms full of clothing.

In the second incident on Monday, June 24th at approximately 2:25 A.M., an unknown male is seen on surveillance video attempting to open the same rear door, except this time it is locked. The suspect locates a nearby object and repeatedly throws it at the door in an attempt to gain access to the business. The suspect is unsuccessful in his attempts and ultimately leaves the area.
