MISSING CHILD

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is requesting assistance from the public in locating a missing female child who was taken by her father against a court order.

Preliminary investigation has revealed, Carlyssa Pasquet was in the custody of her maternal grandmother at her grandmother's home in the 200 block of SW 20th Street within the City of Fort Lauderdale. Carlyssa's father, Carlos Pasquet, came to the home at approximately 2:26 pm and left with Carlyssa with the grandmother's knowledge. The grandmother later contacted the Fort Lauderdale Police Department who discovered that Carlos was only allowed supervised visitation with Carlyssa.

Carlyssa is a 23 month old, H/F, approximately 24 inches tall and 29 pounds. She was last seen wearing a teal flower shirt and green pants.

Carlos is a 39 year old (DOB 05/21/1980), H/M, approximately 5'9, and 195 pounds. Carlos has tattoos on both arms and gold teeth. He was last seen wearing a gray shirt with "Sherwin Williams" printed in blue lettering, black pants, and white and black sneakers.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department, in conjunction with various other law enforcement agencies, have exhausted all attempts at locating Carlyssa and Carlos.

It is not believed that Carlos intends to harm Carlyssa however, he is not properly equipped to care for the child and is in violation of a court order.
