FLORIDA BICYCLE MONTH

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is again partnering with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to continue our efforts in promoting pedestrian and bicycle safety. The month of March is recognized as Florida Bicycle Month.

The campaign is designed to improve traffic and pedestrian safety through high visibility enforcement, with an emphasis on education.

Our officers will be conducting periodic high-visibility enforcement efforts and saturating areas where a high volume of traffic crashes involving bicycles and pedestrians occur. The goal is to make contact with drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians and emphasize education on traffic safety and crash prevention.
