**FORENSIC EVIDENCE  
LEADS TO HOMICIDE  
CHARGES**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a double homicide that occurred on Tuesday, June 9<sup>th</sup> at approximately 6:15 a.m. The incident occurred in the 3054 North Ocean Drive in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed the bodies of two adults males were discovered by pedestrians in the area. The victims were pronounced dead on scene.

The victims have been identified as Walter Amryan, W/M, DOB 7/26/1960 and Adan Gonsulez, H/M, DOB 4/4/1983 and are transient residents of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

While detectives were on scene, an aggravated assault occurred nearby at 2522 Center Avenue. This incident led to a police pursuit on Interstate 95. The pursuit ended and the suspect was taken into custody for the aggravated assault.

The suspect was identified as Daniel Dovi, W/M, DOB 5/25/1956, a resident of Pennsylvania.

Detectives believed, based on the initial information, that Dovi was involved in the double homicide. Forensic evidence was analyzed and later confirmed his involvement.

Dovi has been charged with the following: two counts of premeditated murder, two counts of aggravated battery with a deadly weapon, two counts of aggravated assault, and feeling and eluding.
