DETECTIVES SEEK TO IDENTIFY BUSINESS BURGLARY SUSPECTS

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating two business burglaries believed to be related. The first burglary occurred at Popeye's, located at 1355 West Sunrise Boulevard, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, on Sunday, July 19th, at approximately 5:00 a.m. The second occurred at the Subway, located at 201 East Sunrise Boulevard, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, on Tuesday, July 21st, at approximately 12:28 a.m.

Preliminary investigation has revealed, during both burglaries, the suspects used a large blunt object, possibly a rock or brick, to shatter the front door of the businesses to gain entry. Surveillance footage was retrieved from both businesses and it captured two thin Black male suspects, wearing jogger style pants, gloves, and shirts covering their faces. One of the suspects can be seen wearing the same Nike sandals in both burglaries.
