HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on Wednesday, September 2nd at approximately 11:57 a.m. The homicide took place at 1500 Northwest 22nd Court in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Two males were involved in a physical altercation when one of the males produced a handgun and shot the other male several times. When officers arrived, they discovered a male victim with multiple gunshot wounds lying on the ground unconscious. The officers began to perform chest compressions until Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue arrived on-scene. The victim was transported the Broward Health Medical Center where he succumbed to his injuries.

The victim has been identified as Tyler Reese, B/M, 2/3/96, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

This remains an active and on-going investigation.
