DETECTIVES ARREST VEHICLE BURGLARY SUSPECTS

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating numerous vehicle burglaries that have occurred in public parking lots along Fort Lauderdale beach during the last month. The investigation, thus far, has led to the arrest of two suspects.

Preliminary investigation identified a suspect vehicle used in several of the burglaries. On Sunday, August 30th, 2020, Fort Lauderdale Rapid Offender Control (ROC) Unit detectives observed the vehicle enter the Sebastian Parking Lot, located at 3031 Sebastian Street.

While in the parking lot, a male passenger exited the vehicle and burglarized a parked vehicle. The suspect stole a backpack and two handguns from inside the vehicle. When the suspects attempted to leave the parking lot, nearby detectives stopped the vehicle and successfully took two suspects into custody.

The suspects have been identified as Lametriss Lemon, B/F, 04/27/1979, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale and Clinton Walker, B/M, 08/04/1986, a resident of the City of Sunrise. Lemon was charged with Burglary and Grand Theft of a Firearm. Walker was charged with Burglary, Grand Theft of a Firearm, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, and other related charges.
