HIT AND RUN WITH SERIOUS INJURIES

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a hit and run with serious injuries that occurred at approximately 8:11 p.m. on Sunday, September 27th. The crash occurred at the intersection of East Las Olas Boulevard and Hendricks Isle in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed a green golf cart was traveling westbound on East Las Olas Boulevard in the right through lane. A 2020 black Chevy Impala was traveling directly behind the golf cart in the same lane. The Chevy Impala rear-ended the golf cart causing it to roll onto the driver side. The driver of the Chevy Impala fled from the scene. Ultimately, the Chevy Impala was located unoccupied in the area and seized.

The passengers of the golf cart have been identified as Alex Jean, B/M, 4/28/1989 and Stephanie Chocron W/F, 4/26/1990, both residents of the City of Fort Lauderdale. Both passengers were transported to Broward Health Medical Center for their injuries.

Investigators are seeking the public's assistance in identifying the driver of the Chevy Impala who caused this traffic crash.

This is an active and on-going investigation.
