SHOOTING HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on Sunday, February 14, 2021, at approximately 4:25 p.m. The incident occurred at 1123 Northwest 3rd Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation revealed the victim was shot while outside of his girlfriend's apartment. The shooting was captured by nearby surveillance cameras and shows the victim speaking with two males in the street, just prior to the shooting.

Witnesses to the homicide reported the victim's vehicle had been burglarized the day prior to the shooting. The victim approached the two males in the street because he believed one of them to be the suspect from the burglary. The burglary was also captured on video surveillance.

The victim was transported to Broward Health Medical Center where he succumbed to his injuries. He has been identified as Harry Garcon, B/M, 10/05/1989, a resident of Miami-Dade County.

The shooter is described as being a B/M, with short-twisted hair, wearing dark colored basketball shorts, a white shirt, and black slides. The second suspect is described as being a B/M, wearing a white hat, gray shorts, a white shirt, and red slides. Detectives believe both suspects may be juveniles.

Detectives are seeking the public's help in identifying all involved suspects to this incident.
