FATAL HIT & RUN

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a fatal hit and run crash that occurred on Monday, May 10th at approximately 9:24 p.m. The crash occurred in the 3600 block of West Davie Boulevard in the city of Fort Lauderdale.

Investigators have learned a newer model black Dodge Charger, with dark tinted windows, was traveling eastbound on Davie Boulevard in the right lane when it struck an adult female pedestrian. Investigators believe the pedestrian left the south sidewalk and was attempting to cross Davie Boulevard from the south side to the north when she was struck.

The pedestrian was pronounced dead at the scene and has been identified as Lamerice Morency, B/F, 04/02/1986, a resident of the city of Fort Lauderdale.

The driver of the vehicle fled from the scene without attempting to render aid or contacting police to advise of the incident.

Traffic Homicide Investigators believe the suspect's vehicle sustained noticeable damage to the front end and windshield from the impact of the crash.

The investigation into this fatality remains active and on-going.

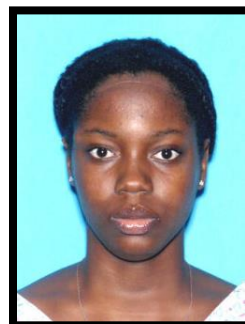
