## TRAFFIC ADVISORY: PRIDE FORT LAUDERDALE PARADE AND FESTIVAL

The Pride Fort Lauderdale Parade and Festival will take place this weekend on Saturday, November 20<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, November 21<sup>st</sup> from noon to 9:00 p.m. on both days. The event will be held on Fort Lauderdale Beach at Fort Lauderdale Beach Park, located at 110 South Seabreeze Boulevard.

The event includes a parade on Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. that will travel southbound in the northbound lanes on A1A. The parade will begin at Riomar Street and end at Southeast 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Motorists on the beach should expect delays and will encounter detours to continue traveling on A1A. The primary detour route will utilize Birch Road.

Although Fort Lauderdale Police Department personnel will be posted throughout the event and parade route assisting and monitoring pedestrian and vehicular traffic, anyone commuting in the area should anticipate moderate congestion and possible delays.
