DETECTIVES SEEK TO IDENTIFY SUSPECT IN OCCUPIED RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating an occupied residential burglary that occurred on Tuesday, January 4, 2022, at approximately 4:00 a.m. The incident occurred at 1608 Northeast 9th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that the suspect entered the residence through an unlocked side door to the home. Once inside the home, the suspect spent approximately 30 minutes rummaging through a vehicle parked in the garage and stealing items from inside of the home while the victims were asleep. The suspect stole two key fobs and a wallet before leaving through the home's front door. He then used one of the key fobs to steal one of the vehicles from the residence. Video surveillance collected from the scene shows the suspect leaving the home.

The suspect is a white male between 25 to 35 years old, approximately 5'6" to 5'8", approximately 150 to 170 pounds, and believed to wear black rimmed glasses. He is seen in the video wearing an orange hat, a black hoodie, one black glove, black jogger style pants, and black sneakers.
