MEDIA ALERT – PARKING FOR NIKOLAS CRUZ TRIAL

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is continuing to follow developments in the Nikolas Cruz court proceedings. Beginning today, Monday, April 4th, intermittent lane closures will be in place along Southeast 6th Street from Southeast 3rd Avenue to Southeast 1st Avenue to accommodate media vehicles. Parking in this area is first come first serve and media credentials must be displayed at all times. Please do not block the crosswalks, fire hydrants or the intersections.

Associated fees must be paid for any vehicles parked inside of a garage or in a metered parking spot. Vehicles parked outside of the designated media parking area-highlighted in red on the below map-will be subject to fines and/or be towed at the owner's expense.



The Fort Lauderdale Police Department has designated the area highlighted in red for media parking and it was strategically selected for its proximity to the feed box provided by court officials. The Fort Lauderdale Police Department reminds our media partners not to park on the sidewalk or in the roadway.
