DETECTIVES SEEK TO IDENTIFY BURGLARY SUSPECT

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a vehicle burglary that occurred on Friday, April 15, 2022. The incident occurred at 501 Southeast 2nd Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed the victim parked his car in the apartment complex's parking garage on Thursday night, April 14th. The victim took his car keys and building access fob with him inside the building. While walking to his apartment, the victim accidentally dropped his car key and key fob. The next morning, the victim discovered that his vehicle had been burglarized and that his wallet had been stolen. He was also informed of \$3,000.00 worth of fraudulent transactions on his credit cards.

Records collected from the apartment complex indicate that an unknown suspect utilized the victim's key fob to exit the apartment's parking garage on April 15th at approximately 4:30 a.m. Video surveillance from the apartment complex shows the suspect in the lobby area of the apartment complex and later leaving the garage in a dark colored Nissan sedan, consistent with the key fob records.

The male suspect is described as a medium build Hispanic male, with short black hair, and brown eyes. He is seen in the video wearing a blue polo shirt, khaki shorts, and brown shoes.
