TRAFFIC ADVISORY: 2023 LAS OLAS ART FAIR

The 2023 Las Olas Art Fair Part II will take place on East Las Olas Boulevard beginning Saturday, March 4th, to Sunday, March 5th, from approximately 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department will have personnel stationed throughout the festival and event site to guide pedestrians and motorists and ensure public safety. Attendees are reminded to “see something, say something,” by reporting any suspicious activity to the nearest uniformed police officer or by calling 911.

Road Closures:

- For the duration of the event, East Las Olas Boulevard will be closed from Southeast 6th Avenue to Southeast 8th Avenue and Southeast 8th Avenue to Southeast 11th Avenue.
- Southeast 8th Avenue:
 - Southeast 8th Avenue will be open to traffic north and southbound until 11:00 a.m. both Saturday and Sunday.
 - After 11:00 a.m. each day, Southeast 8th Avenue will only be open to northbound traffic. Southbound traffic on Southeast 8th Avenue will be detoured at Southeast 2nd Court until 7:00 p.m.
- Any guests of the Riverside Hotel can access Southeast 4th Street from Southeast 11th Avenue.
- Southeast 11th Avenue will remain open for the duration of the event.
