On March 3, 2009, at approximately 12:30 P.M. Lewis Frederick was located in the 2800 block of Northwest 10 Court in Fort Lauderdale. Frederick was in good condition and was taken back home.

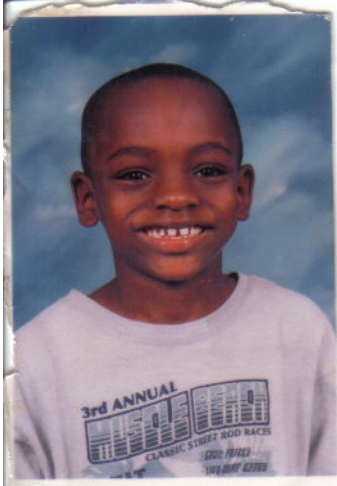
The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is asking for help from the public in locating an 11 year-old boy who ran away yesterday and has not been located.

Lewis Frederick was arguing with his older brother when he became angry and left their residence at 1107 NW 3rd Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, at approximately 7:00pm on Monday, March 2, 2009. Lewis was not wearing shoes or a shirt but was wearing red shorts.

Officers have searched the entire area surrounding the residence, made contact with friends and neighbors, checked hospitals and shelters, and initiated A Child is Missing program with negative results.

Lewis has been described as 4 feet tall, 80 pounds, brown eyes and short brown hair. The attached photo was taken last year.
