2023 TORTUGA MUSIC FESTIVAL

The Tortuga Music Festival will be held on Fort Lauderdale Beach, 1100 Seabreeze Boulevard, on Friday, April 14th to Sunday, April 16th, from approximately 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. each day. For the duration of the event, a portion of the beach will be designated for the festival and will not be available for public use.

Traffic Advisory:

Motorists should expect delays on all barrier island roadways especially A1A and Seabreeze Boulevard. Delays should also be expected on Southeast 17th Street and Las Olas Boulevard. For all three nights of the event, there will be a short road closure for both northbound and southbound traffic from Harbor Drive to Southeast 5th Street from 9:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. to allow the crowd to safely exit the venue. During this closure, all vehicular traffic south of East Las Olas Boulevard will be funneled northbound on A1A or westbound off the barrier island over the East Las Olas Boulevard bridge.

There will be no designated event parking. Attendees are encouraged to use a rideshare service or the Fort Lauderdale Water Taxi for transportation to and from the event. Taxis and rideshare services are to utilize the designated pick-up and drop-off location in the Las Olas Circle (300 Las Olas Circle). Rideshares could face fines for picking up or dropping off outside of the designated area. For more information about transportation, please visit <https://tortugamusicfestival.com/getting-here/>.
