BANK OF AMERICA
ROBBERY

On Monday, March 23, 2009 at approximately 1:00 P.M., an unknown male robbed the Bank of America located at 4901 North Federal Highway, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

According to detectives, the suspect entered the bank wearing a baseball cap and sunglasses. The suspect had on a light-colored polo shirt and appeared to be unshaven. The suspect approached the bank teller with a note and demanded money. The teller complied with the request and turned over the cash to the suspect.
